Dr. Bill Roston Native Butterfly House

10 am-6 pm, Saturdays & Sunday · Free · May-Sept

The Gray-Campbell Farmstead

South Creek Greenway Trail

This is the quintessential 8-mile urban trail, set in a natural landscape. Walk, bike or jog along the newest part of the National Recreation Trails System. Trailhead includes parking and restrooms. 3-miles of hard surface trail runs throughout the park.

A Look Back: History of the Park

The new 12,700 sq. ft. Botanical Center rests on a hillside in the 55-acre Close Memorial Park, just south of 59-acre Nathanael Greene Park. Known as Nathanael Greene|Close Memorial Park, the 114 acres share the main entrance from Scenic Ave. Open dawn to dusk.

Nathanael Greene is named after a major general of the Continental Army in the American Revolutionary War. The land was received as surplus property from the U.S. Dept. of the Interior and Bureau of Prisons in 1975.

Close Memorial was established in cooperation with the Springfield-Greene County Park Board in 1998. The purchase was made possible in part through a donation from the C.M. Close family. A MO Dept. of Conservation grant in 2003 helped expand the park and clear it to create open space.

Federated Garden Club Gardens

Annuals and perennials are planted and maintained by Brentwood, Cherry Court, Ever Green and Hillbilly Gardeners Garden Clubs.

Missouri Native Arboretum

Throughout Close Park, several native tree species are identified with green signs which teach about our Missouri forests. Brown signs indicate non-native and ornamental trees and shrubs. These serve as guides for the homeowner. The latest additions include the Cercis (Redbud), Dwarf Conifer, and Azalea Gardens.

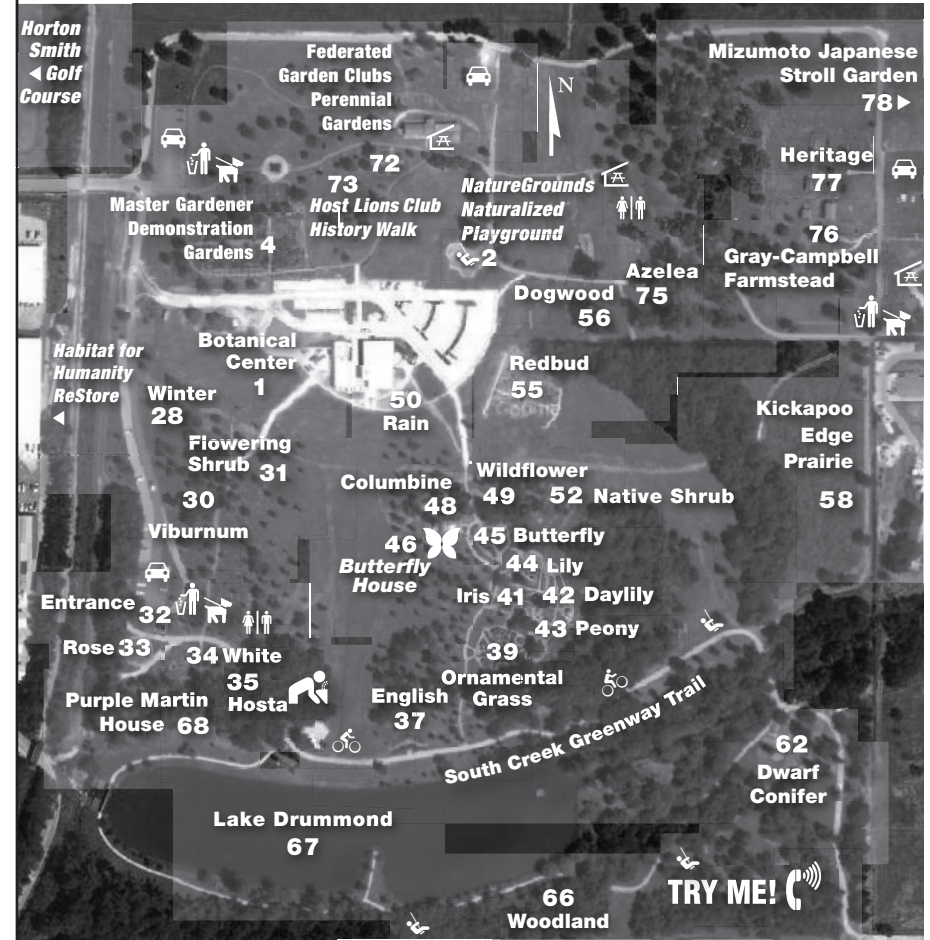
